**May 30, 2008**

**Friday**

**9am – 9pm Artist Check In**

**Location Gate 3**

- ≈ Artist must show Drivers License or Photo ID at check in to participate in the show.
- ≈ Artists may pull into the show site if the ground is firm.
- ≈ Place your vehicle pass in your front window.
- ≈ Park as close to your booth space leaving room for other artists to load in.
- ≈ NO STAKING
- ≈ After unloading please move your vehicle to one of the parking lots or along the streets. A 70' no parking zone will be enforced around each gate opening.
- ≈ Booth Signs must be displayed in the front of your booth.
- ≈ 24 hour access for showing artists with photo ID
- ≈ Artist's booth spaces will be marked in white spray chalk. Flags will hold artists name and number at the "back wall Center" of the booth.
- ≈ No Overnight Parking in San Gabriel Park.

**May 31, 2008**

**Saturday**

**6am – 8am**

- ≈ Artists allowed vehicles on site for final set up

**8am – 9am**

- ≈ Artist Breakfast served in the covered eating area near the stage
- ≈ Artist Breakfast delivered to artists until all is gone.

9am – 6pm

- ≈ Show open to the Public for a \$5.00 Admission (good both days)
- ≈ Artist Relief – Volunteers in white aprons “Artist Relief” are available to artists for: 15 to: 30 minute breaks during festival hours.
- ≈ Patron Art Pick Up is available at Gate 3. Artists may take their large pieces to Gate 3 Patron Pick Up. Security will watch the art until the patron brings their vehicle to load up.

6pm Admission becomes free for Art In The Park

7pm

- ≈ ARTIST MAY CLOSE AND LEAVE or Stay Open – (artist choice)

8pm

- ≈ Temple Symphony Orchestra at the Gazebo

9pm

- ≈ Fireworks on the banks of the San Gabriel River.
